What Solutions are Available?

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Possible Solutions:

1. Installment Agreement.

An Installment Agreement (IA) is an arrangement with the IRS to pay your back taxes in monthly payments, instead of making one large payment. Payments are made in a series of multiple and smaller amounts over an extended period of time. The amount of your payment depends on a number of factors such as how much you owe, your financial situation and the amount of time the IRS has to collect the tax. 2. Offer in Compromise.

An Offer in Compromise (OIC) is a settlement with the IRS for those taxpayers that don't have the ability to full pay their tax debt. An OIC allows a taxpayer to settle their back tax liability for a reduced amount. The IRS looks at a taxpayer's past, current and future facts and financial situation when evaluating whether an OIC should be accepted. If you qualify for an OIC it is a great way of settling your back taxes and starting over. After an OIC has been accepted the IRS expects taxpayers to be compliant with their taxes in the future. 3. Currently Not Collectible.

A Currently Not Collectible (CNC) status temporarily stops IRS collection activity and provides a taxpayer with a break from paying

their IRS back taxes. The IRS does not collect back taxes from taxpayers while they are on a CNC status. The IRS has a limited amount of time to collect taxes. In some cases, a taxpayer's situation improves and the taxes are paid at a later date. In others, the situation stays the same and the time the IRS has to collect the back taxes may expire. 4. Tax Account Review Service.
